Directions to Campus

There are no physical addresses for any of Princeton's Athletic Facilities. If you are unfamiliar with campus, we recommend you visit <http://g.co/maps/qta3f> to get directions to the check-in/check-out location.

Check-In

Campers should arrive no later than 9:00am to Roberts Stadium. Parking will be available in Lot 18 which is adjacent to the field.

Waiver of Liability

Each camper is required to submit a Waiver of Liability at check-in. This form must be completed in full and signed by the camper's parent/guardian. We are unable to allow a camper to participate in any session without the completed form.

Extreme Weather

All sessions will take place regardless of weather conditions. In the event of extreme conditions, we will make an effort to contact you at home if the clinic has been cancelled or rescheduled. We will also post any cancellations on our Facebook and Twitter pages.

What to Bring

Campers need to bring their own lunch or money to purchase lunch on Saturday. Campers should also bring a water bottle or any sports drink they may want.
