



2022-23 Princeton Sports Camps & Clinics COVID-19 Requirements

IMPORTANT - COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE FULLY VACCINATED. Full vaccination is defined as 2 weeks after the second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or 2 weeks after the one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. Participants for camps/clinics must have the booster if they meet the age requirement for that dose as well. During the registration process the individual completing the registration form will need to attest that the person associated with the registration is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (including booster if eligible) and meets the Princeton University visitor guidelines (<https://covid.princeton.edu/policies>).

LIMITED ACCESS ON CAMPUS. Please limit the number of individuals traveling to campus with each camper and keep in mind that spectators may have limited access during indoor and outdoor sports camps/clinics.

MEDICAL & RELIGIOUS EXEMPTIONS. Medical and religious exemptions will not be accepted for 2022-23 Sports Camps & Clinics.
